

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An Authentic Terroir



Home to some of Italy's finest extra-virgin olive oil and wines, the Medieval village of Loreto Aprutino is rich in history, culture and authentic traditions. The earliest evidence of grape growing in the area is found in Pliny the Elder's Natural History, where the early naturalist and Roman philosopher wrote about a vine, and referred to our Trebbiano d'Abruzzo as vinum trebulanum. The Tavo valley is internationally recognized for producing Abruzzo's first bottle of Montepulciano d'Abruzzo DOC and Italy's first DOP extra-virgin olive oil.










The Family

Talamonti was founded by the Redmont-Di Tonno family in a magnificient, unspoilt part of the Central Italian region of Abruzzi. Antonella and Rodrigo set out to make a premium, yet affordable Italian wine with the commitment of sustainable winemaking and agriculture.

The Estate



Founded in 2001, the Estate lies at an altitude between 200 to 400 meters above sea level, extending over an area of 45 hectares under vine and olive groves on steep south-facing slopes. The Gran Sasso and the Majella mountain ridges shield the estate from harsh weather and thus helps to provide Talamonti with a unique micro-climate in which to produce its famous Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Trebbiano d'Abruzzo and Pecorino. Our daily objective lies in constantly seeking the best interaction between the varietal in our vineyards, the sun-exposition, the training methods, and the desired yield with the sole desire to best express our unique terroir.
