INTRODUCTION

The Italian aeronautics and space sector exported around AUD 9.3 billion in 2019, with an increase of 7.5% compared to the previous year. Characterised by the second highest level of expenditure in R&D by Italian companies, the sector occupies a leading position in the international context, fourth in Europe and seventh in the world. Apart from some Prime contractors, 80% of the national supply chain is made up of SMEs concentrated mainly in seven technology districts. These are companies with excellent skills, enhanced by the collaboration with large national industries, research centres and universities, which have earned the 'Italian system' a leadership position in different fields of aeronautics and space. The field of activities is vast, ranging from the assembly of aircraft, helicopters and microsatellites, space launchers, boats and military vehicles, to systems and subsystems (landing, defence systems, pointing, on-board and land-based communications, radar, flight attitude, etc.) to individual parts and components, to design and engineering, experimentation and testing, maintenance, etc.
