- Test functionality of all forms, newsletter and other databases and routines
- Update the Wordfence plugins (firewall, malware scanners)
- Update the MailPoet newsletter plugins
- Make regular backups of the site
- Create and analyze the access statistics
- Handle the Web hosting services and DNS management subscription, which ITA will pay for separately from this contract
- Provide training sessions (at least 3 hours) on content management and backend interface use
- B) Extraordinary maintenance and site modifications, based on a prepaid package of 20 hours, specifying the hourly rate, taking care of activities like the following ones, which are just a few examples.
 - Plan and apply modifications to multiple pages, both in the content and the page design
 - o Provide training sessions on new implementations

Italian law does not allow advance payments for public contracts. Therefore, the payment schedule must comply with the following criteria:

- 50% of the fee payable after signing the contract, upon receipt of an invoice.
- The final 50% payment shall be made only upon deliveries of services and receipt of an invoice.

7. PENALTIES AND TERMINATION CLAUSE

The contract that will be signed between the Consulate General of Italy-Italian Trade Commission and the selected winner will include a clause specifying penalties to be applied in case of delays and non-compliance in delivering the goods and services. If the agreed-upon project timeline and deadlines are not met, ITC shall apply a penalty fee equal to the amount of 5% of the total price set forth in the contract, in addition to any other right or remedy that ITC may have at law or otherwise.
