# **REQUIRED CATERING SERVICES**

We require the following catering services.

MASTERCLASS FROM 10:30-12:00PM for 70 people

 plain bread cut into small pieces and displayed in bread baskets (baskets provided by Roy Thomson Hall) for the morning masterclass in the theater for 70 people. 1 bread basket to be shared every 2 people for a total of 35 baskets with bread.

# THREE (3) BUFFET STATIONS FROM 11:00-5:00PM for 1,000 people

Must be replenished as needed so that a sufficient quantity of food will be available until the end of the event. The food stations will be located as follows.

- 1. 1 in south lobby
- 2. 1 in north lobby
- 3. 1 in passageway between north and south lobby

A light buffet to be served during the duration of the event, with the following features. Please note that products mentioned below are just examples but each category must be present in the buffet. Please ensure that there is sufficient food until the end of the event.

- The food stations should include platters of "Made In Italy" <a href="Italian">Italian</a> <a href="Italian">imported</a> cheeses and charcuterie such as for instance Parmigiano Reggiano, Taleggio, Pecorino Toscano, Piave, Provolone, Prosciutto di Parma (The Original), Mortadella, various specialty breads (e.g. focaccia, olive flatbread, cheese flatbread, Italian bread), other suggestions, with the exclusion of dips. For the cheese platters please provide staff in attendance to cut and serve the cheese for the duration of the event.
- Warm dish to be served from 12:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. (local specialty without any strong odors).

### WALKAROUND TASTING

The awarded bidder must ensure that all **86** tables of the Italian Wine producers have baskets of sliced bread to be placed on the tables (one basket for every table). Baskets must be replenished as needed, i.e. often.

#### DRINKING WATER STATIONS

- distributed around north and south lobby with small white disposable biodegradable glasses (not paper cones)

### **BUDGET AND TERMS OF EXECUTIONS**

**Total maximum budget allocated** for all the services requested in this RFQ (including all fees, expenses, services, goods, products, hipping etc.) cannot exceed **CAD \$48,000.00** (**CAD forty eight thousand dollars**), excluding applicable taxes.



Although your quotation needs to include a price for all products and services indicated in this RFQ, the ITC reserves the right to change items, quantities or entire parts of this quotation when stipulating the service contract with the awarded venue and/or during the life of the contract.

ITC may cancel this RFQ and reserves the right to reject in whole or in part any and all bids.

ITC will not consider claims for an increase or decrease of the total contract value.

#### REQUIREMENT FOR THE SUBMISSION OF OFFERS AND DEADLINE

Please send your itemized quotation (page 5) by October 16, 2023 to toronto@ice.it including all the following price points.

- Staff and supplies (we count on your experience to define the exact number of personnel and hours required for the smooth running of the event). It is important to define the required hours of work for staff because once accepted, it will not be possible to add more.
- Buffet stations provide menu and cost per guest according to the items listed above
- Company profile
- List of at least 3 similar events carried out in the last 2 years
- All additional items we might have not included in this RFP and which you deem necessary for the successful outcome of our event
- As required by the applicable Italian Law, by submitting its offer the Supplier agrees to sign the following:
  - Anti-pantouflage clause
  - Code of Conduct clause

# **PAYMENT TERMS**

Italian law does not allow advance payments for public contracts. Therefore, the payment schedule must comply with the following criteria:

- 20% of the fee payable after signing the contract, upon receipt of an invoice
- The final 80% payment shall be made at completion of the event, upon receipt of an invoice

Payment will be issued by EFT-Direct Deposit in CAD within 30 days of receipt of original invoice addressed to the ITC office indicated in the Purchase Order (PO).

The contract that will be signed between the Consulate General of Italy-Italian Trade Commission and the awarded company will include several clauses, including one specifying penalties to be applied in case of delays and non-compliance in delivering the goods and services.

\*\*As part of new procedures for all of the ITC branches worldwide, it is mandatory that all suppliers of services and goods, Individuals or Companies, that wish to work with our office register with the ITC. The awarded bidder will be requested to register before a contract can be executed. All bidders are invited to be registered in order to receive invitations to restricted tenders.
