





Economic context



Research and innovation centers



Gran Sasso National Laboratory (LNGS) is one of the four national laboratories of INFN (National Institute for Nuclear Physics).

The other laboratories of INFN are based in Catania, Frascati (Rome) and Legnaro (Padua).

The whole network of laboratories house large equipment and infrastructures available for use by the national and international scientific community.

Located between L'Aquila and Teramo, at about 120 kilometres from Rome, the underground structures are on one side of the 10-kilometre long highway tunnel which crosses the Gran Sasso massif (towards Rome); the underground complex consists of three huge experimental halls (each 100-metre long, 20-metre large and 18-metre high) and bypass tunnels, for a total volume of about 180.000 m3.

The 1400 metre-rock thickness above the Laboratory represents a natural coverage that provides a cosmic ray flux reduction by one million times; moreover, the flux of neutrons in the underground halls is about thousand times less than on the surface due to the very small amount of uranium and thorium of the Dolomite calcareous rock of the mountain.



SEZ : everything you need to know

SEZ is a geographically delimited and clearly identified zone that can be accessed by companies that start an **entrepreneurial economic activity** within it.

The **Abruzzo SEZ** is characterized by **advantageous taxation** and an articulated system of **administrative simplifications**, which can be accessed by companies for the extension of production facilities located in the SEZ territories or that start a new entrepreneurial economic activity within it. The facilities are available to **all companies** both newly established and already established within the area.

European Incentives

Horizon Europe

European Union framework program for research and innovation for the period 2021-2027. The Program is implemented directly by the European Commission. Research and innovation activities funded by Horizon Europe must focus exclusively on civil applications. The overall objective of Horizon Europe is to achieve scientific, technological, economic and social impact from EU investments in research and innovation

Euratom Research and Training Programme Euratom aims to pursue nuclear research and training activities with an emphasis on continually improving nuclear safety, security and radiation protection

Life program for environment and climate action

Program that finances projects of various sizes that aim to demonstrate the technical and economic feasibility of effective solutions (techniques, methods and approaches) to different and complex environmental and climate change problems



European Incentives

Single Market Programme

The €4.2 billion Single Market Programme will strengthen the governance of the EU single market. It will help to make the internal market work better with measures including improved market surveillance, problem-solving support to citizens and business, and enhanced competition policy; to boost the competitiveness of businesses, small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs); to give even higher protection to consumers; to maintain a high level of food safety etc.

European Space Programme

EU space policy aims to tackle some of the most pressing challenges today, such as fighting climate change, helping to stimulate technological innovation, and providing socioeconomic benefits to citizens

Ambitious international project to build the world's biggest fusion machine, advance fusion energy technology for a greener and more sustainable energy mix. For the period 2021-2027, an additional €5 billion is expected for the signing of R&D contracts and industrial contracts for the completion of the ITER project and the start of its operations



National Incentives

• R&D for circular economy

It supports the transition of economic activities towards a circular economy model, supporting **R&D projects** aimed at a more efficient and sustainable use of resources

• Development contract

The R&D&I projects for companies and research and knowledge-dissemination organizations. The investment size is about € 20 MLN and € 50 MLN for high-impact projects

• IPCEI

The abbreviation of *Important Project of Common European Interest*, which allows the possibility of public funding to be granted at a national level. IPCEI features projects with a dedicated focus on R&D as well as First Industrial Deployment (FID)

Innovation Agreement

The Innovation Agreement is aimed at projects concerning industrial research and experimental development activities with eligible costs at least equal to \in 5 MLN for the development of new products, processes or their improvements

• Law 181/89

Strategic national incentive scheme of at least € 10 MLN that foresees a relevant workforce increase. It is a Mix of grant and soft loan, up to **75%** of the total eligible investments

• Tax credits for tangible/intangible assets

Companies investing in tangible and intangible capital goods in line with the Transition 4.0 national strategy, or in "ordinary" tangible and intangible assets can benefit from tax reductions up to 50% of total investments

National Incentives

• Tax Credits for R&I

Companies investing **in research**, **development and technological innovation** can benefit from tax reductions up to **45%** of total investments

• Patent box

Total 210% deduction (normal 100% + an extra 110% deduction) for **R&D expenses** associated to qualified intangible assets, i.e., software protected by copyright, industrial patents, designs, and models

• Industry 4.0 training

Companies of all sizes investing in **training of employees and entrepreneurs** for the acquisition or consolidation of skills in technologies relevant to the Industry 4.0 national plan, can benefit from **tax reductions up to 70%** of total investments • Smart & Start

Initiative to foster the birth and growth of **innovative startups** in Italy, through the development and/or improvement of innovative technological solutions on the national territory

• Employment Bonuses

Reduction, or total exemptions, in social security contributions which, by law, must be paid by employers. This financial support has the aim to encourage the hiring of certain categories of people: women, under 36, over 50 etc.

• Italian green new deal

This incentive scheme is aimed at projects concerning **industrial research**, **experimental development** and – only for SMEs – industrialization activities with eligible costs between € 3 MLN and € 40 MLN

National Incentives

• ON - Beyond New Zero-Interest Enterprises

The incentive is for young people and women who want to become entrepreneurs. The concessions are valid throughout Italy and provide for a mix of zero-interest financing and non-repayable grants for business projects with expenses of up to 3 million euros, which can cover up to 90% of the total eligible expenses

• Hard to abate

The measure supports investment projects and research and development projects for the decarbonisation of industrial processes, mainly through the use of lowcarbon hydrogen, in sectors that are today more polluting and difficult to convert, and which use fossil fuels as a source of energy (cement, paper mills, ceramics, glass industries, etc.). The incentive is promoted by the Ministry of the Environment and Energy Security. The financial envelope, drawing on the resources made available by Mission 2, Component 2 of the PNRR for the implementation of Investment 3.2 "Use of hydrogen in hard-to-abate sectors", is equal to 1 billion euros.

• Development contracts – Production chains




Life science & Pharmaceutical


