Angelo Russica began his fashion journey assisting **Giorgio Correggiari**, where he met **Domenico Dolce and Stefano Gabbana**. After a brief military pause, he joined Barbas and later worked as assistant designer to **Gianni Versace**, contributing to the **Genny, Spazio, and Versus** collections.

He gained industrial experience in Spain at **Induyco – El Corte Inglés in Madrid**, developing a rare mix of creative and production know-how. This dual perspective led him to consult for major fashion groups like **Marzotto, Max Mara, Miroglio**, and internationally with **Lancy Group (China), World Co., and King Company (Japan)**.

He **founded Milan Fashion Campus**, first as an **innovative online education platform**, which later **evolved into a physical school in Milan**. The Campus has since become a globally recognized institution, *licensing its Women's Fashion Styling Course* across borders to countries like **Uzbekistan, Mongolia, and Thailand** — continuing Angelo's mission to share Italian fashion expertise with the world.
