Canneta Brunello di Montalcino 2020

Score: 93 Points

October 16, 2024

16 Oct, 2024 – Layers of fruit for a 2020 with ripe plums and berries. Full body with round, crunchy tannins and a savory finish. Plenty of complexity and length. A classic Brunello in many ways. Best after 2028.

Canneta Brunello di Montalcino Riserva 2016

Score: 95 Points

11 Dec, 2023 – This is a really structured 2016 with plenty of fruit and lots of toasted wood. Chocolate and hints of caramel. Full and juicy with a savory undertone. It's really impressive and quite opulent. One for the cellar. Try after 2026.

Canneta Brunello di Montalcino 2019

Score: 93 Points

25 Sept, 2023– Lots of dark fruits such as black berries, blue plums and violets with licorice undertones. Medium- to full bodied with firm and chewy tannins. Refreshing acidity with a subtly spicy aftertaste. Healthy and balanced. Drink after 2028

Canneta Rosso di Montalcino 2022

Score: 92 Points

18 Dec, 2024 – A restrained wine with layered complexity from cinnamon, violets, roses, dried cherries and raspberries. This light- to medium-bodied interpretation shows velvety tannins soaked with flowers, crisp acidity and a savory, mineral finish. Drinkable now, but best in six months.





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Canneta Brunello di Montalcino 2018

Score: 91 Points

29 Nov, 2022 – Pretty nose of lavender, raspberries, plums, sandalwood, cumin, bark and white pepper. Medium- to full-bodied, with fine and sleek tannins, bright acidity and lovely transparency.

Drink from 2023.

Canneta Brunello di Montalcino 2017

Score: 91 Points

19 Nov, 2021 – A pleasant mix of plummy and berry fruit, together with easy mineral, almost nutty notes. Medium-to full-bodied with tightly woven tannins that pull a little on the finish for now. Give it a couple of years to unravel. Best from 2024

Canneta Brunello di Montalcino 2016

Score: 92 Points

3 Apr, 2021 – Full-bodied and full-flavored Brunello with black-plum, black-fruit and some mild fresh-licorice character. Silky palate and a fresh finish. This is well-poised and attractive now, but give it a little more time. Best from 2022.

Canneta Brunello di Montalcino Riserva 2013

Score: 93 Points

9 Jan, 2019 – This shows some ripe red-cherry and plum aromas with a thread of warm terracotta, leading to a mid-weight palate that carries a bright, fleshy berry core. Fine and tight, plummy finish. Drink or hold.

Canneta 2018 Brunello di Montalcino

Cranberries and top soil show first on the nose of this wine before violets, rose petals and wild fennel appear. Lively and fresh, the palate offers cherries, strawberries, blackberries, hints of bitter orange, and then more soil and wild herbs. Tannins are dusty and taut, and the acid zings.

Canneta 2007 Brunello di Montalcino

This Brunello presents a classic, textbook bouquet with red fruit, spice, cola and pressed flowers but with a subdued, mild delivery.

The wine shows aromatic intensity but not in an exaggerated fashion.

The tannins are dry, firm and dusty and there's a wood-driven finish of spice and rolled pipe tobacco.

Toscana	I Mori	Chianti Riserva	2016	90	Rosso
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Structured and complex on the nose with a good presence of balsamic notes that confirm the cold vintage in Chianti. Hints of mint, eucalyptus and black currants in the main aroma of this young wine. Full body, rigid tannins and a radiant finish. Drink now or get old.

Toscana	I Mori	Chianti	2018	88	Rosso
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The slight initial reduction leaves space for notes of raspberries, currants and lemon peel. Medium body, slightly green tannins and a clear and clean finish. Few devices to improve here. Drink now.

A rich red, this starts out open and accessible, turning denser and taut as it develops.

The finish is very tight and firm, yet overall this is well balanced and the black cherry, raspberry and black tea notes remain intense and focused.
