## MATERIAL INTEGRITY

Natural composite stone and flame-worked glass, shaped through material research and structural balance

COKI was founded by Coki Barbieri in 2018 as her material and craft practice, rooted in long-term research into mineral traditions and flame-worked glass.

The studio works with a proprietary natural composite stone developed without cement, resins, or synthetic binders. The material is formed through mineral aggregation and mineral-based binding processes inspired by Roman and early artificial marble traditions.

Raw Italian mineral fragments and earth pigments are combined, shaped, and finished by hand through slow manual processes. Flame-worked borosilicate glass is shaped without molds and integrated into each composition as structure, containment, or light-bearing element.



COCHLEA COLLECTION

Sculptural vessels in natural composite stone and flame-worked glass

Inspired by the fluid movement of land snails, Cochlea explores balance through stone and glass. Each piece is assembled without permanent fixings, relying on precision, weight, and structural equilibrium.



CATHARSIS COLLECTION

Sculptural objects in natural composite stone and flame-worked glass

Catharsis explores rupture, pressure, and release through fractured mineral forms shaped by gravity, gesture, and rapid control, echoing the way lava falls, spreads, and solidifies into terrain.

A mineral light system developed around ethically sourced Italian rock salt and hand-formed borosilicate glass, awarded with the Green Product Award and selected for "Sate...Light 1998-2022" and the SaloneSatellite Permanent Design Collection, curated by Marva Griffin Wilshire.
