it has a medium vigorous and rustic tree, disease resistant, suitable for biologic agriculture, without the use of pesticides and chemical fertilizers.

The fruits have an average size up to 600 grams, with a higher juice yield than the other varieties on the market, because of the thin peel.

The peel has an orange-yellow background color and red rose color. The arils are deep red, large, aromatic and juicy, with sweet taste, over 16° Brix, with low acidity around 0,70 % expressed in citric acid.

The pomegranate matures between the end of September and the beginning of October. Excellent aptitude for cold storage, over five months.
