Although this is a repeatable, made-to-measure collection, each piece will always be unique and unrepeatable: the shape of the selected tree trunks, the grain of the wood, and the patterns formed by the sand inside the glass make every creation different each with its own identity and its own story to tell.



COLUMNA

Columna celebrates authentic and balanced connection. Oak, rooted in the earth, speaks of strength and bond with nature, while the central lava stone acts as a unifying core a thread of connection. The glass, traversed by black sand, reflects light and time, creating a space that welcomes thoughts and words. An invitation to sharing, where every element - wood, stone, sand, and light - reminds us that what truly binds us is the earth that embraces us.

ARCA VINARIA

Arca Vinaria is a retreat from frenzy, an invitation to genuine pause.

Crafted from raw solid oak, it celebrates the beauty of natural imperfection and the marks left by time on what is real.

The top hosts a humidor for cigars, while a small stone tray beside it holds spirits, glasses, and a poem engraved in Sicilian dialect, a living memory of gestures and traditions. Each element is carefully chosen to evoke a slow, convivial ritual rooted in the land and culture.

The inner shelves hold only the essentials: a few carefully selected objects, for intimate and meaningful gatherings without haste.

A piece that does not merely contain it welcomes. It does not just decorate, it tells a story. Area Vinaria doesn't furnish a space: it transforms it into a moment to live.



TRISPITE

The legs, hand-carved from solid wood, stand opposed to show that every truth has a counterpart; within them, leather details and two perforated metal paintings depict a rising sun and a calming sea symbols of newfound peace when one chooses to change perspective.

Existence is a work about contemporary man: about his search for meaning, his need for control, and the beauty that lies not in perfection, but in living matter.


Sometimes, to find the light, all it takes is to shift by a few centimeters.


OROMARE

Oromare is a sculptural table, a tribute to the golden light of my land.

Four hand-carved solid wood legs, with essential shapes and gentle curves, represent the living strength of roots: solid, tactile, golden-edged like sun-kissed earth. At the center, six discs of lava stone glazed in gold seem to float in space: they are inner suns, symbols of warmth, creativity, and the light that shapes our Mediterranean identity.

Every element is handmade: the gold leaf caressing the undulating carved edges recalls the sea reflecting the sun, eternal movement and beauty. This piece is not just a table it is a domestic altar to light, a work of art that blends nature, myth, and culture.

It is dedicated to my island, land of poets, philosophers, and artisans, where the sun is not just a physical phenomenon, but an eternal source of inspiration.





NESSENTE

Nessente, a mirror console/room divider inspired by Pirandello (One, No One and One Hundred Thousand).

Nessente is a reflective space, an object that invites you to slow down and recognize yourself.

Composed of three vertical rough wood planks, with visible bark and natural imperfections, it embodies the fragility and authenticity of the human being. On each plank is placed a mirror with an antique gold finish: three reflections, three masks, three identities overlapping and shifting.

A slab of lava stone glazed in gold runs through the three elements like a river of life flowing, symbolizing time that unites and transforms. With a solid yet open structure, the mirror also serves as a room divider, creating an intimate, protected space where the image does not judge but welcomes.

TERRA FLAMEA

From the scorched roots of orange trees, a new form of beauty is born.

This console regenerates what fire once destroyed, turning scarred, surviving wood into material poetry. Every grain tells an interrupted story, every knot reveals a strength that endured.

This is more than furniture, it's a symbol: life that returns, ashes that become light, elegance that arises from rebirth.

















The structure is completed by swiveling feet made of steam-bent sequoia wood, designed to enhance its dynamism without compromising elegance.
