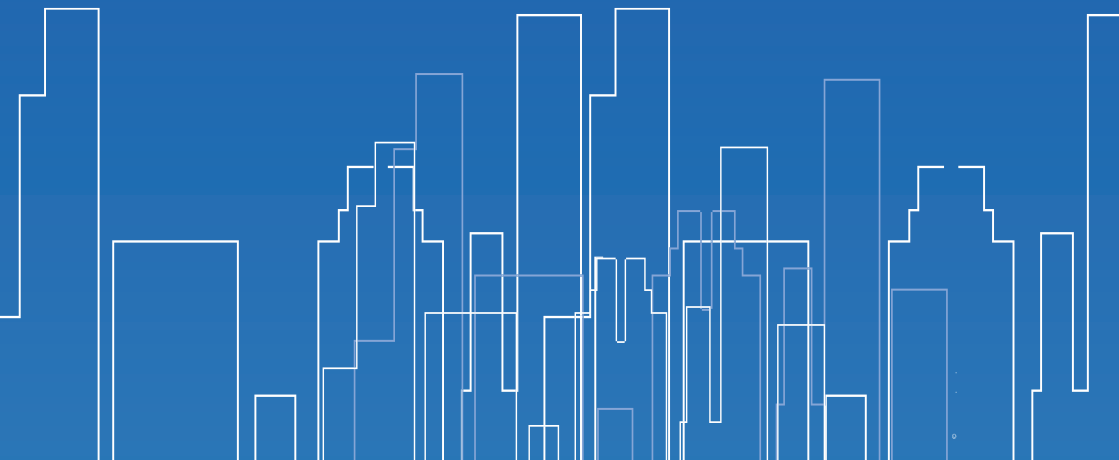
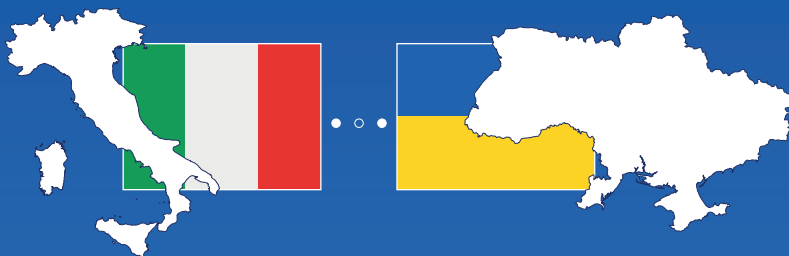

I am extremely pleased to extend a word of welcome to all participants to the 5th edition of the Rebuild Ukraine Conference in Warsaw, which marks the continuation of the Ukraine Recovery Conference (URC2025), held in Rome on 10 and 11 July, and paves the way for the next year's URC edition.

The Rome's Conference has offered international partners and donors a unique opportunity to coordinate their action and reassert their commitment to providing financial, economic and humanitarian support to Ukraine, along with

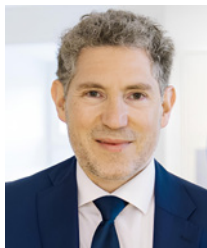
the political and defense backing. Compared to the previous editions, the URC2025 has been the largest so far with over 7,000 participants, including 2,000 companies, and the most productive one with 70 sessions, 700 speakers, 4,000 B2B and 500 G2G meetings, as well as 120 booths within the Business Fair, organised in cooperation with the Italian Trade Agency (ICE). This adds to over 400 agreements and memoranda signed during the event, which round up to 15 billion euros of new public and private commitments for the recovery and reconstruction of Ukraine.

Italy, along with all of its national institutions, local authorities, businesses, and civil society organizations, played a pivotal role in the Conference, with over 500 business associations and companies in attendance, among which many have started new partnerships with their Ukrainian counterparts. Thousands of businesses and public administrations, including a large and high-level delegation from Poland, had a chance to meet and discuss the most relevant challenges and opportunities related to the recovery and reconstruction of Ukraine in dedicated panels, sectoral workshops and networking events. Businesses will now have the opportunity to take advantage of the many insurance programs and financial instruments launched during the URC2025, including an innovative and dedicated European Equity Fund, with Italy as a founding member through CDP, to become operational in 2026.

Today, I am particularly glad to see many of these business associations and companies taking part in this year's Warsaw Conference, which marks a noteworthy increase compared to last editions and confirms the success of Italy's comprehensive engagement in support of Ukraine and its people. The topics chosen for the Rebuild Ukraine 2025, including strategic industries and investments, are priority areas in which we intend to continue our joint work and promote partnerships which are beneficial for Italy, Ukraine, Poland and all our major partners. I wish to extend to all guests my best wishes for a productive and impactful conference and exhibition.

The solution is sensor-agnostic, cloud-based, and used by major infrastructure operators like Italgas, Tesla, RFI, and Italgas. While focused on civil applications, the technology is dual-use and adaptable to defense and security contexts.

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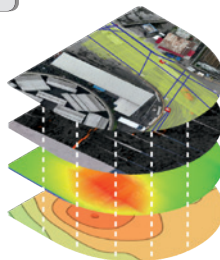
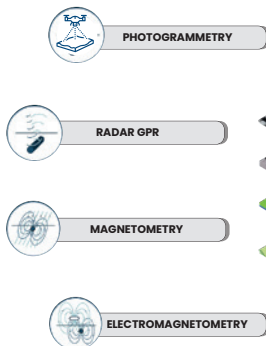
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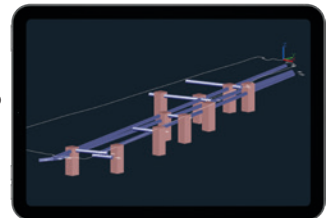
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
