#### Major Projects Kick Off in Huangpu District, Shanghai

On February 24, 2026, Shanghai's Huangpu District held a ceremony to launch its major 2026 projects. The annual plan includes 65 key projects, covering approximately 7.5 million square meters, with a total investment of 485 billion yuan (approximately €62.1 billion). The annual planned investment is 43 billion yuan (approximately €5.5 billion), up 10% year-on-year. **(Tencent News)**

#### Beijing Releases First Batch of Urban Renewal Projects for 2026

Beijing published its first list of urban renewal projects for the year 2026. The list contains 1,321 projects, including 745 new ones and 576 carried over. The planned annual investment totals approximately 104.95 billion yuan (approximately €13.4 billion). This list covers two main categories: newly implemented projects and projects carried over from previous phases. **(People's Daily Online)**

#### Hebei Province Issues Key Construction Project List

On February 24, 2026, Hebei Province released its 2026 key construction project catalog. According to the list released by the Hebei Provincial Development and Reform Commission, the list of key construction projects in Hebei Province for 2026 comprises 747 projects with a total investment of 1.56 trillion yuan (approximately €199.7 billion), including 365 new projects and 382 continuing projects. **(Tencent News)**

#### Shanghai's Major Project Investment Hits Record High

Shanghai announced its 2026 major project plan at a construction conference. It includes 184 formal projects, with an annual planned investment of 255 billion yuan (approximately €32.6 billion), setting a new record. The plan calls for starting 16 new projects and completing 22. In 2025, Shanghai's total investment reached 251.01 billion yuan (approximately €30.9 billion), a year-on-year increase of 5.3%. **(People's Daily Online)**

#### Beijing Unveils 2026 Rail Transit Construction Plan

The 2026 Beijing Rail Transit Construction Plan has been officially released. In February 2026, the Beijing Major Projects Construction Command held a mobilization and deployment meeting for rail transit construction. This year, Beijing will comprehensively promote the construction of 9 urban rail transit lines totaling 150.6 kilometers and 2 suburban railway lines totaling 90.5 kilometers. **(Beijing Municipal Development and Reform Commission)**
