EU Issues Preliminary Anti-Dumping Ruling on Adipic Acid from China

The European Commission issued a notice issuing a preliminary anti-dumping ruling on adipic acid originating from China. The period of investigation for dumping in this case is from January 1, 2024 to December 31, 2024, and the period of investigation for injury is from January 1, 2021 to the end of the dumping investigation period. **(European Commission website)**

EU announces Final Safeguard Measures on Certain Imported Ferroalloys

The European Union announced that it has decided to implement final safeguard measures on certain imported ferroalloys to protect its ferroalloy industry. According to a statement released by the European Commission that day, the final safeguard measures will last for three years. Ferroalloys are key materials for improving the hardness, tensile strength, wear resistance, and corrosion resistance of steel. **(China News Network)**

Ethanol Import and Export Statistics for October 2025

China's imports of unmodified ethanol in October 2025 were 8.776 tons, a decrease of 67.87% month-on-month. The largest import volume was from Germany, at 6.40 tons. China's exports of unmodified ethanol in October 2025 were 1202.76 tons, a decrease of 11.72% month-on-month. The largest export volume was to Papua New Guinea, at 256.20 tons. **(ChemNet)**

Port potassium chloride inventory in the third week of November 2025 was 2.174 million tons

Port potassium chloride inventory in the third week of November was 2.174 million tons, a decrease of 75,000 tons compared to the second week of November and a decrease of 1.075 million tons compared to the same period 2024. The potassium chloride (import) index was 112.17, a decrease of 35.76% from the cycle high of 174.60 points (June 2022) and an increase of 92.57% from the cycle low of 58.25 points (August 2020). **(China Inorganic Salts Industry Association)**
