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China's AI education market is projected to reach \$16 Bln. in 2034

The China AI in education technology market size reached \$ 846.1 Million in 2025. The market is projected to reach USD 16,252.10 Million by 2034, growing at a CAGR of 38.87% during 2026-2034. The market is driven by government-mandated AI curriculum integration across all primary and secondary schools.

China attracts 380,000 international students, marking growth in global education appeal

A total of 380,000 international students from 191 countries and regions were studying in China during the 2024–2025 academic year, about 8 percent of the total enrollment. In terms of regional distribution, Asian students made up the largest share at 61.1 percent, followed by Africa at 16.2 percent, Europe at 15.6 percent, and the Americas and Oceania together at 7.1 percent. China unveils student wellbeing framework, shifting focus from academic pressure

China's Education Ministry announced a comprehensive framework to promote students' physical and mental health. The new measures include banning schools from assigning excess homework, prohibiting encroachment on student break time, and banning frequent examinations. Schools are now required to ensure at least two hours of physical activity daily for primary and secondary students. (**US News**)

MOE sets 2026 priorities for digital education and AI integration

China's Ministry of Education outlined priorities for the next phase of the country's digital education strategy, focusing on personalized learning in schools, digital platforms for lifelong learning to boost graduate employability, and university-industry research collaboration. A new platform version was released with modules for lifelong learning, research and innovation, language education, and education data services.
