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Malaysia Plans Land Route for Durian Exports to China

Malaysia is negotiating with Thailand and Chinese customs to launch a cheaper overland durian shipping route to tap China's second-tier cities, targeting 229 million USD durian export revenue to China by 2030 and lifting its market share from 4%-5% to 8%-10%; its fresh and frozen durian shipments to China surged sharply in 2025 amid huge national demand worth nearly 7 billion USD. **(Asia Fruit)**

First Shipment of Zimbabwe Blueberries Arrives in China

Delecta Fruit delivered Zimbabwe's maiden blueberry air cargo to China after gaining Chinese customs access in September 2025; the fruit enjoys zero-tariff benefits, while Zimbabwe's blueberry output is rapidly expanding and aims to become Africa's top blueberry exporter with supportive policies. **(Guojiguoshu)**

Strong Chinese Demand Boosts Philippine Pineapple Exports

OECD and FAO forecast global pineapple exports will rise 1.4% annually to 3.8 million tons by 2035, with China's pineapple imports growing 5.9% yearly for premium Philippine MD2 pineapples; the Philippines ranks as the world's second-largest pineapple exporter and seeks full U.S. port access to lift its shipments greatly. **(Asia Fruit)**

Chinese Dairy Industry Wins Global Innovation Recognition

At the 2026 Global Dairy Congress in Barcelona, Yili Group claimed two World Dairy Innovation Awards; industry leaders noted China's dairy sector develops fast via heavy R&D, shifting to precision functional nutrition and building cross-border research hubs to adapt to diverse global market demands. **(Xinhua News)**

China Accelerates Smart Farm Upgrades via Machinery Renewal Policy

Under China's national large-scale equipment renewal initiative, the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Affairs has significantly boosted subsidies for scrapping obsolete farm machinery.
