The use of the customer attendance registration book is only allowed at areas without internet coverage or other reasonable grounds (senior citizens, the absence of smartphones etc.). • Licensees and premise owners ensure customers check in the premises using MySejahtera or manually write the name and phone no. in the absence of internet coverage. • Customers and visitors are required to check in MySejahtera or manually write name and telephone number that is readable before entering the premises. • For shopping malls, supermarkets or department stores, customers need to conduct a body temperature scan only once at the entrance of the complex and not at every business premise under one complex. • Body temperature above 37.5 degrees Celsius is not allowed to enter the complexes and premises. • The owners of the complexes and premises outside the complexes need to ensure only customers with "Low Risk" status including "Casual Contact Low Risk" in MySejahtera is allowed to enter their respective complexes or premises.
