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The list of national logistics hubs for 2025 has been officially released

Thirty logistics hubs in 25 cities have been selected, with the first specific "cross-border national logistics hub" category established. This initiative aims to strengthen international supply chain organization and build a modern logistics system encompassing "channels, hubs, and networks." These hubs help reduce logistics costs by improving operational efficiency. **(CCTV News)**

First energy-grid-load-storage logistics park nears completion

Inner Mongolia's first green energy, low-carbon logistics park (Wuhai Wuda) is expected to be completed by the end of October. It integrates solar power, storage, charging, and battery swapping, and is expected to save 10 million kWh of electricity and reduce carbon dioxide emissions by 7,200 tons annually, setting a new benchmark for the green transformation of the logistics industry. **(Sina Finance)**

AI Empowers Transportation and Logistics Upgrades

The Ministry of Transport issued the "Implementation Opinions on "Artificial Intelligence + Transportation", aimed to build a comprehensive transportation model, upgrade intelligent ports and intelligent postal and express delivery facilities, coordinate computing power supply and data set construction, strengthen security management, and establish an application security grading and classification system. **(Xinhua Net)**

World's fastest high-speed train hit 453 km/h in pre-operational testing

The CR450 has begun pre-operational testing on the Shanghai-Chengdu high-speed railway. Its maximum test speed is 450 km/h, and its commercial operating speed is 400 km/h (compared to the CR400's operating speed of 350 km/h). Compared to the CR400, its aerodynamic drag is reduced by 22%, and its weight is reduced by 50 tons. **(China Daily)**

Xi'an International Low-Altitude Economic Development Conference held

The Second China (Xi'an) International Low-Altitude Economic Development Conference opened from October 10 to 12. Over 430 exhibitors and over 20 buyer delegations from Belt and Road countries participated. The conference is themed as "New Opportunities in Low-Altitude Aircraft, New Economic Engines Co-creating a Digital Future", and generated over 20 billion yuan (\$2.8 billion) in contracts. **(Sina Finance)**
