China's transport sector posts stable growth from Jan-Sept 2025

China recorded 50.6 billion cross-regional trips in the first three quarters of 2025 (+3.1% year-on-year), according to the Ministry of Transport on October 29. Freight operators moved 43.25 billion metric tons of goods during this period (+3.89% y/y). Meanwhile, ports across the nation handled 13.57 billion tons of cargo (+4.6% y/y). Investment in transport infrastructure reached 2.6 trillion yuan (\$357 billion). **(China Daily)**

China-Europe freight train network grows as competitive link to overseas markets

Completed over 110,000 round-trip transports from January to July of 2025, with goods worth over US\$450 billion, China-Europe Railway Express links 128 Chinese cities, reaching 229 cities in 26 European countries and over 100 cities in 11 Asian countries. It has three domestic routes (western/central/eastern) and three overseas corridors covering almost the entire Eurasian continent. **(China Daily)**

New policy Cultivating & Opening New Scenarios for Large-Scale Application released

This policy, issued by the General Office of the State Council on November 9, aims to promote the application of unmanned systems across land, sea, and air, construct clean energy vehicle transportation corridors; develop smart highways, smart ports and shipping, smart logistics hubs and innovate application scenarios such as unmanned transportation and smart warehousing. **(Ministry of Transport)**
