Automotive production, sales, and exports hit record highs for the same period

Data from China Association of Automobile Manufacturers (CAAM) on October 14 showed that automobile production and sales in the first three quarters exceeded 24.3 million units (up 12.9% year-on-year), with new energy vehicles accounting for 46.1%. Exports of pure electric vehicles account for 1.13 million units (up 54.6%) and plug-in hybrid vehicles account for 628,000 units (up 2.2 times). (Sina Finance)

New vehicle production access regulations seek public comment

On October 14, the Ministry of Industry and Information Technology publicly solicited public opinion on the "Entry Review Requirements for Road Motor Vehicle Manufacturers", with cybersecurity and autonomous driving as key review focuses, raising the security threshold for intelligent connected vehicles and clarify capability requirements for network and data security, as well as autonomous driving. Major policy implementation: six departments set target of \$1.4 trillion

The "Work Plan for Stabilizing Growth in Machinery Industry (2025-2026)" six departments issued late month got full interpretation, setting binding targets of 3.5% two-year average annual revenue growth, pioneering supply-demand synergy mechanism, deploying 14 tasks (replace 200000 industrial machine tools, 1 million industrial robots in two years and \$11.2 billion agricultural machinery trade-in subsidies). SINOMACH Heavy Equipment 2025 Supply Chain Conference was held in Deyang on October 13 During the conference themed "Intelligent Manufacturing of Heavy Equipment, Chain-Building the Future," SINOMACH Heavy Equipment and Sinohydro 14th Bureau agreed to jointly develop plateau/deep-sea special scenario equipment and explore Southeast Asia and Africa markets. A key resource sharing and emergency supply mechanism has been established. (Sina Finance)

2025 China Heavy Machinery Equipment Exhibition was held from October 15 to 17 in Zhengzhou Held in Zhongyuan International Convention and Exhibition Center, the exhibition area spans 32,000 square meters and features over 500 exhibitors from home and abroad. Themed "Innovation Drives, Connecting the Future," the exhibition focused on showcasing innovative achievements in metallurgical forging machinery, mining machinery, and material handling machinery.
