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Smart Tech Fuels Satellite Manufacturing In Zhejiang

A Taizhou-based company, Geesatellite, uses AI and auto-industry mass-production techniques to manufacture satellites in just 28 days, compared to 1-2 years traditionally. Production speed increased 10 times, with annual capacity reaching 500 satellites. The smart factory uses robotic arms and AI quality inspection, producing low-orbit satellites for communication and data needs. **(China Daily)**

NEV exports to Belt and Road countries surge 59.4% in H1

In the first half of 2026, China's new energy vehicle (NEV) exports to Belt and Road Initiative (BRI) countries hit 1.135 million units (+59.4% year-on-year). Total NEV exports reach 2.355 million units (+120%). Overall auto exports reached 5.31 million units (+53% year-on-year), of which 3.381 million were exported to BRI (+48.1% year-on-year). June NEV exports 523000, 50.4% of monthly total. **(China Daily)**

NEVs Grab Over 60% Of Deliveries In July

In July, sales of new energy vehicles (NEV) in China reached 1.56 million units, 60.4% of total vehicle sales (+23.7% year-on-year); from January to July, sales of NEV reached 9 million units (51.2% share). July exports totaled 1.043 million units (+81.3%), of which NEV exports reached 553,000 units (a year-on-year increase of 145.5%). Jan-Jul exports 6.14 million, NEV exports 2.91 million. **(China Daily)**

Chinese EVs Reshape Australia's Car Market

Australia's July new vehicle sales hit a record 103,656. Battery EVs captured 21.7% (23,510 units) for the second straight month above 20%, up from 7.6% last June. Chinese brands held four top 10 spots, with Geely EX5 jumping to 2,034. Experts say this indicates a genuine shift to mainstream EVs. Chinese manufacturers set the pace via affordability and strong supply chains. **(China Daily)**

Electric Machinery Exports Show China Driving Green Transition

In the first half of 2026, China Machinery Manufacturers Association (CCMA) data shows electric loader exports rose 172% to 1,643 units, excavators 60.7% to 135. Total export value grew 21.7% to \$34.37 billion, with EU, ASEAN, Africa and Latin American countries up 28.9%, 23.6%, and 44.1%. Exports now offer green, digitalized, customized solutions, not just machines, driving green transition. **(Global Times)**
