INTRODUZIONE

La Polonia è il primo beneficiario di Fondi UE.

Da dopo la sua adesione all'UE nel 2004, la Polonia ha ottenuto finanziamenti per 80 miliardi di euro per il periodo 2007-2013 (67,3 miliardi da fondi strutturali e di coesione e 14 miliardi da finanziamenti per l'agricoltura e la pesca).

Con la programmazione 2014-2020 sono stati assegnati alla Polonia 82,5 miliardi di euro tra fondi strutturali e di coesione, ai quali si aggiungono 37,2 miliardi di euro per l'applicazione della PAC – Politica Agricola Comune.

I fondi UE vengono assegnati ai soggetti beneficiari attraverso i Piani Operativi (nazionali e regionali).

I principali strumenti di realizzazione della politica di sviluppo delle regioni nel periodo 2014-2020 sono:

- il *Fondo Europeo di Sviluppo Regionale*, che finanzia le infrastrutture, gli investimenti produttivi intesi a creare posti di lavoro, i progetti di sviluppo locale e gli aiuti alle piccole e medie imprese;
- il *Fondo Sociale Europeo*, che favorisce l'adeguamento ai mutamenti del mercato dell'occupazione e l'inserimento professionale dei disoccupati e delle categorie sfavorite finanziando le azioni di formazione ed i sistemi di incentivi all'assunzione;
- il *Fondo di Coesione* mirato a finanziare le infrastrutture di trasporto e di tipo ambientale.

Oltre ai suddetti Fondi, di cui i primi due sono Fondi strutturali, esistono anche alcuni strumenti speciali con l'obiettivo di assicurare una gestione efficiente dei finanziamenti, come per esempio JEREMIE (Risorse europee congiunte per le micro, le piccole e le medie imprese) e programmi gestiti direttamente dalla Commissione Europea nell'ambito dei quali è possibile ottenere sovvenzioni (es. Programma quadro per la competitività e l'innovazione).

Altri strumenti finanziari sono: il Fondo Europeo Agricolo per lo Sviluppo Rurale, che promuove lo sviluppo sostenibile delle aree rurali, e il Fondo Europeo per la Pesca finalizzato tra l'altro a rafforzare la competitività nel settore della pesca. Entrambi i fondi

non rientrano nell'ambito della politica di coesione, ma fanno parte della politica agricola comune.

Le imprese italiane, al pari delle aziende polacche e di altri paesi europei, possono essere coinvolte nelle attività sia direttamente (costituzione di società di diritto polacco) che indirettamente (fornitura di impianti, tecnologie e servizi necessari agli investimenti strutturali).

La programmazione 2007/2013 ha dato degli ottimi risultati. A fronte di 74 miliardi di investimenti (il 97,5% del budget a disposizione) è stato registrato un ritorno in contratti stipulati di circa 98 miliardi di euro con 24 miliardi di utili.

Per il monitoraggio e la gestione dei fondi la Polonia ha creato un ufficio a livello centrale che riferisce direttamente al Governo e che si occupa del coordinamento e della programmazione dei fondi, attraverso il controllo delle attività di regioni e provincie, la verifica dei progetti e dello stato di avanzamento dei lavori.

In appendice si trovano i bandi di gara di maggior interesse dell'ultimo trimestre.

INTERSCAMBIO ITALIA POLONIA

La Polonia scambia con l'UE ben oltre il **60%** (import) e poco meno dell'**80%** (export) del suo commercio internazionale. Secondo i dati provvisori relativi all'intero anno 2016 le esportazioni - 183,6 miliardi di euro (+2,35) - hanno registrato per il secondo anno consecutivo un valore superiore al valore delle importazioni - 178,9 miliardi di euro (+0,9%) con un saldo commerciale attivo di 4,76 miliardi di Euro rispetto al 2015 (2,35 miliardi).

L'interscambio Italia-Polonia nel 2016 è stato di 18,3 miliardi di euro registrando un incremento dello 0,6% rispetto al 2015 e un saldo positivo per l'Italia di 661 milioni di euro. Le importazioni dall'Italia in valore nel 2016 sono state pari a 9,5 miliardi di euro, sostanzialmente invariate rispetto all'anno precedente, mentre le esportazioni polacche in Italia hanno registrato un valore di 8,8 miliardi con aumento dell'1,8% (8,68 miliardi nel 2015).

L'**Italia** con una quota del 5,3% è il **quarto fornitore** della Polonia dopo Germania (23,4%), Cina (12,1%) e Russia (5,8%).

I principali mercati di sbocco della Polonia sono invece: Germania (27,3%), Regno Unito (6,6%), Rep. Ceca (6,6%), Francia (5,5%) e Italia (4,8%) in quinta posizione.

Continua la tendenza positiva anche nei primi mesi del 2017.

NOTIZIE FONDI EUROPEI

Varsavia: nuovi appalti per la Metro 2 all'inizio 2018

Sulla Metro 2 (Ovest – Nord Est), attualmente operativa solo nel centrocittà, è in corso la cosiddetta fase 3+3 (3 tratti+stazioni ad Ovest (quartiere Wola) e, oltre il fiume Vistola, 3 tratti+stazioni al Nord Est (verso il quartiere Targowek). Il tutto dovrebbe essere messo in uso nel 2019 e più in particolare entro Natale il tratto ad Ovest ed entro l'Estate 2019 il tratto Est / Nord Est.

Il Municipio di Varsavia Sic sta preparando nuovi appalti concernenti la 2° parte della cd. Fase 2+3, ovvero lavori per la costruzione di Metro 2, che include 2 tratti+stazioni all'estremo Ovest (quartiere Bemowo, fino all'incrocio Gorczewska/Powstancow Sl.) e 3 al Nord Est (quartiere Brodno, fino all'incrocio Rembielinska/Kondratowicza). I relativi appalti andrebbero banditi entro il 1° trimestre 2018.

Per quanto concerne la 1° parte della Fase 2+3, ovvero la progettazione, i relativi contratti sono stati firmati nel 2016, e – come informa il dott.ing. Jerzy Lejk, CEO della Metropolitana di Varsavia – tutto procede come previsto: si è vicini a richiedere formalmente il permesso per l'apertura dei cantieri.

La costruzione della S7 potrebbe essere pronta prima del previsto

Andrzej Adamczyk, Ministro delle Infrastrutture e dell'Edilizia, ha annunciato che la fine della costruzione della superstrada S7 potrebbe avvenire prima del previsto. Il percorso in questione va da Lubień a Chabówka e ha una lunghezza totale di 16,7 km. Adamczyk ha ricordato che l'investimento ha un valore di 2,1 miliari di złoty e la strada dovrebbe essere pronta entro il 2021. Le aziende impegnate nella costruzione dei tre tratti della cosiddetta Zakopianka sono il consorzio polacco-ucraino costituito da IDS-BUD S.A. e ALTIS-HOLDING e le italiane Astaldi e Salini Impregilo.

Firmati contratti per la A2, la S17 e la strada nazionale 61

L'aggiornamento del programma di costruzione delle strade nazionali 2014-2023 approvato dal Consiglio dei Ministri ha condotto alla firma di nuovi contratti per il progetto e la costruzione di alcuni tratti autostradali. L'accordo di maggior rilievo è stato siglato da POLAQUA Sp. z o. o., che per 502,5 milioni di złoty realizzerà il tratto della A2 tra

Lubelska e la circonvallazione di Mińsk Mazowiecki. PORR S.A. eseguirà invece i lavori per la parte della S17 che sempre da Lubelska conduce allo snodo di collegamento con la S9 e la A2. Questo contratto ha un valore di 190,4 milioni di złoty. Infine, SKANSKA ha siglato un accordo da 45,7 milioni di złoty per la continuazione della costruzione del viadotto di Legionowo sulla strada nazionale 61 e per il tratto che collegherà il viadotto con via Wolska.

Interreg Central Europe - PPI2innovate – Lublino 3/10/2017

Rzeszowska Agencja Rozwoju Regionalnego S.A. (l'Agenzia per lo Sviluppo regionale di Rzeszow) organizza nell'ambito del progetto PPI2Innovate la conferenza PPI2Innovate Days.

La conferenza si terrà a Lublino presso il Centro Conferenze il prossimo 3 ottobre 2017 ed ha l'obiettivo di incrementare l'utilizzo degli appalti pubblici di soluzioni innovative.

Il progetto è cofinanziato nell'ambito del Programma INTERREG Europa Centrale.

325 milioni di euro dalla BEI per la S7 e la S8

La Banca europea degli investimenti (BEI) ha assegnato ieri 325 milioni di euro di prestito per la costruzione di tre diversi tratti delle superstrade S7 e S8. I percorsi in questione sono di una lunghezza totale di 110 km e si trovano nel voivodato della Masovia. La loro costruzione migliorerà le condizioni del traffico della regione. I lavori sulla S8 sono particolarmente importanti, dato che questa è l'unica strada a scorrimento veloce che collega Varsavia con il confine lituano e con gli altri paesi baltici.

Via libera alla costruzione di un nuovo tratto della A2

Via libera alla costruzione di un altro frammento dell'autostrada A2 che attraverserà i comuni Wiązowna e Halinów. Come ha detto l'ufficio regionale di Masovia il progetto riguarda la costruzione del nodo stradale 'Konik', la ricostruzione delle strade comunali, le piste ciclabili, i marciapiedi, le uscite, l'illuminazione e i nuovi viadotti. L'investitore si prenderà cura pure delle strutture come le condotte stradali, gli schermi acustici, le passerelle pedonali ed i passaggi per gli animali. Secondo il ministro delle infrastrutture Andrzej Adamczyk l'autostrada A2 sarà pronta nel 2021 o massimo entro il 2022, supponendo che non ci siano ricorsi e proteste da parte degli ambientalisti.

Fondi europei per la tangenziale sud di Zielona Góra

Lunedì 10 luglio il Ministero dello Sviluppo polacco ha informato che Zielona Góra - città della Polonia occidentale nel voivodato di Lubusz - riceverà circa 115 milioni di złoty di fondi europei per la costruzione della tangenziale meridionale della città. L'investimento prevede la costruzione di 12,7 km di strada a due corsie e i lavori dovrebbero essere completati nel luglio 2023. Il progetto di Zielona Góra è il 28° investimento nel settore stradale, selezionato nell'ambito del concorso indetto l'anno scorso per il "Programma Infrastruttura e Ambiente".

Fondi europei per 85 milioni di złoty a 10 aziende del voivodato di Santacroce

Il Consiglio amministrativo del voivodato di Santacroce ha rivelato i vincitori di un concorso organizzato nell'ambito di un programma operativo regionale per il sostegno agli investimenti nel settore delle piccole e medie imprese. Grazie a questo programma, 10 aziende regionali otterranno dall'Unione europea fondi per un totale di 85 milioni di złoty. I finanziamenti maggiori (10 milioni di złoty) saranno elargiti a Zefir e alla fonderia di ghisa Fansuld. Le altre aziende che potranno beneficiare del sostegno economico europeo sono Innomed, Hochtrans, Beton, Geoforma, WWTECH, Polstar Door, Polonica, Mar-Plast e Retech. I finanziamenti saranno dedicati a progetti innovativi legati alla modernizzazione delle tecnologie, all'introduzione di nuovi metodi di produzione e alla costruzione di nuovi impianti. Si stima che la realizzazione dei progetti contribuirà alla creazione di 330 posti di lavoro.

L'autostrada A2 sarà collegata con la Via Carpatia

La Direzione generale per le strade e le autostrade della Polonia (GDDKiA) vuole estendere la A2 fino a Biala Podlaska e unirla con la S19, conosciuta anche come Via Carpatia. La A2 taglia la Polonia da ovest a est e quando sarà completata collegherà Świecko con Kukuryki. Secondo la GDDKiA, la realizzazione della A2 darebbe un forte impulso allo sviluppo delle zone orientali della Polonia. La costruzione della strada sarà suddivisa in tre fasi. Il primo tratto sarà lungo 15 km e andrà dallo snodo di Lubelska - al confine orientale di Varsavia - fino alla circonvallazione di Mińsk Mazowiecki e il suo costo stimato ammonta a circa 950 milioni di złoty. Il secondo tratto di 32 km condurrà da Mińsk Mazowiecki a Siedlce e il suo costo è di circa 2 miliardi di złoty. Il terzo tratto collegherà invece Siedlce con Biala Podlaska e avrà una lunghezza di 70 km. La GDDKiA stima che la preparazione della documentazione potrebbe durare circa due anni e altri quattro anni saranno necessari per la gara d'appalto e la costruzione.

La Polonia al 6° posto per l'uso del piano Juncker

La Polonia si trova al 6° posto per quanto riguarda lo sfruttamento dei finanziamenti del piano Juncker. Il piano che porta il nome del presidente della Commissione europea mira a sostenere due settori: i grandi investimenti infrastrutturali e i progetti delle piccole e medie imprese. Nel primo ambito la Polonia è al 5° posto per valore dei progetti, che supera 4,5 miliardi di euro. "Ancora un anno fa in Polonia era previsto solo un investimento per l'edificazione di una fattoria di latte in polvere. Oggi la Polonia ha 18 di questi progetti per un valore di quasi 20 miliardi di złoty", ha commentato il viceministro dello Sviluppo Witold Słowik. Davanti alla Polonia nello sfruttamento dei fondi del piano Juncker ci sono Gran Bretagna, Francia, Italia e Spagna.

Il governo prepara un nuovo emendamento

Il governo sta preparando un emendamento alla legge sull'utilizzo dei fondi UE grazie al quale sarà possibile, soprattutto ai beneficiari pubblici (ad es. comuni), ottenere prestiti ponte per realizzare un progetto, successivamente re-finanziato dai fondi UE.

POLONIA: NOTIZIE ECONOMICO-FINANZIARIE

Gli analisti della Banca Nazionale Polacca (NBP) non vedono alcuna minaccia per l'economia

L'ultimo rapporto sull'inflazione preparato dalla Banca nazionale polacca (NBP) indica che nel prossimo futuro non si prevedono minacce per l'economia polacca, che continua a svilupparsi in modo equilibrato. Secondo le previsioni, la crescita del PIL rimarrà al 4% fino alla fine dell'anno. A questo potrebbe contribuire un significativo aumento degli investimenti, sul quale sta puntando la NBP. L'inflazione sarà influenzata in un senso o in un altro dalla domanda, dall'aumento dei salari e dei prezzi dei prodotti alimentari, ma anche dai prezzi delle materie prime. Secondo gli economisti della banca di Polonia, l'inflazione dovrebbe raggiungere il 2,5% nel 2019. I consumatori sono turbati dall'aumento dei prezzi, ma gli analisti di NBP spiegano che questa situazione è determinata dalla revisione in alto della crescita economica e dal previsto miglioramento della situazione del mercato del lavoro. Dubbi provengono anche dagli scenari futuri dell'economia americana, con incertezza soprattutto per quanto concerne la politica fiscale e monetaria.

A giugno tasso di disoccupazione al 7,2%

Secondo le stime del Ministero della Famiglia, del Lavoro e delle Politiche Sociali, nel mese di giugno il tasso di disoccupazione ha raggiunto il 7,2%. Il dato rappresenta lo 0,1% in meno rispetto a maggio e l'1,5% in meno rispetto al giugno 2016. La diminuzione della disoccupazione ha coinvolto tutti i voivodati polacchi, ma quella più significativa si è verificata in Varmia-Masuria (-0,6%), che tuttavia rimane la regione del paese col più alto tasso di disoccupazione (12,1%).

Fitch conferma il rating della Polonia al livello A-

Venerdì 7 luglio l'agenzia Fitch ha confermato il rating della Polonia al livello A- con prospettiva stabile. Secondo i calcoli dell'agenzia, la crescita del PIL polacco sarà del 3,3% nel 2017 e del 3,2% nel biennio 2018-19. "I redditi delle famiglie sono sostenuti dal calo della disoccupazione e dal programma 500+. L'aumento delle spese provenienti dai fondi europei sosterrà gli investimenti. La Polonia beneficia anche della forte crescita dei partner commerciali dell'Unione europea", scrive Fitch nel comunicato.
