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CNOOC's Bonded LNG Bunkering Volume Surpasses 800,000 Cubic Meters

On June 22, China National Offshore Oil Corporation (CNOOC)'s bonded LNG bunkering volume surpassed 800,000 cubic meters after “Haiyang Shiyu 301” refueled at Shenzhen Yantian Port. Its two bunker vessels have completed 143 operations (ops), covering Shenzhen, Ningbo, Guangzhou, Hong Kong and Xiamen with both berth and anchorage services, enabling sea-river integrated supply. **(Sina Finance)**

Puguang Gas Field's Tongnanba Block Gas Prod Tops 800M Million cubic Meters

As of June 22, 2026, Sinopec's Tongnanba tight-gas block at Puguang has produced more than 800 million cubic meters of cumulative gas, with 47 wells online and stable output surpassing 1 million cubic meters per day. Its "fault-fold-fracture" theory locked in 100 billion cubic meters reserves, and peak well open flow hit 1.59 million cubic meters per day. **(Netease)**

3 High-End Green Vessels Delivery Ahead Of Schedule Same Day

On Jun 30, Hudong-Zhonghua delivered 3 fully self-developed green high-end ships ahead of schedule, two 174000 cubic meters liquefied natural gas (LNG) carriers (3-5 months earlier than expectation) and one 13000 twenty-foot equivalent unit (TEU) dual-fuel container ship (6 months earlier than expectation). LNG carrier backlog nears 60, more than 20% global share, booked through 2031. **(Sina Finance)**

Changqing Oilfield's Oil And Gas Production Has Remained Stable With A Slight Increase

In the first half of 2026, Changqing Oilfield reported oil and gas equivalent 34.1672 metric tons (51.54% of annual plan), new energy 150800 tons of standard coal equivalent (TCE), and green power 344 gigawatt-hour (GWh), with deep coalbed methane (CBM) carbon dioxide fracturing and carbon capture, utilization and storage-enhanced gas recovery (CCUS-EGR) pilots. **(Sina Finance)**
